Career and Technical Student Organizations

Students at CIT that go above and beyond have the opportunity to participate in several student organizations. SkillsUSA, National Technical Honor Society, DECA, HOSA, and the newly formed CIT Media Crew allow students to grow through competitions, service projects, and leadership training. By participating in these organizations, students can showcase all of their talents and fully experience the benefits of a career and technical education.

SkillsUSA is a nationwide organization that provides students in career and technical education with opportunities to learn leadership, public speaking, and professional skills through trainings and competitions. Students can compete on the local, regional, and national level to earn scholarships and tool awards. There is something for every student in fields like customer service, job application, and program specific competitions.

The National Technical Honor Society is open to 11th and 12th students and exceptional 10th grade students who meet the requirements regarding grades and attendance.
