Coming off a busy week in Washington, I'm thrilled to be back in the district for the next few weeks to spend time with friends, family, and people across our community. This week was Congress' last voting week of the year, and we were busy with legislative business. We passed several important pieces of bipartisan legislation this week, including the National Defense Authorization Act which is critical for our national security, the National Plan to End Parkinson's Act, and the Whole Milk for Healthy Kids. You may remember that I'm a Co-Chair of a Climate and Clean Energy Task Force. This week, our task force released a slate of bills that will help unleash America's clean energy potential and lower energy costs for Americans. I will continue advocating for legislation to protect our climate for our children, and get costs down while doing it!

Finally, like many of you, I have been heartbroken by the devastating news coming out of Gaza about the horrific loss of innocent lives. This week, I called on the Biden Administration to use all the tools they have available to achieve an extensive humanitarian pause in Gaza and to immediately resume negotiations to safely return the hostages. Pedestrians, cyclists, drivers and even school children alike are expected to have a safer experience along Bethlehem's West Broad Street as part of a \$9.9 million grant, officials said Monday.
