

Let Your Voices Be Heard Regarding the Redrawing of the 'Slate Belt'

The Deadline To File Your Comments Or Objections Is Tuesday, Jan. 18

SLATE BELT - Update: As a follow up to last Tuesday's redistricting email, I wanted to offer some clarification to questions I have received. In regard to those who live in Upper Mount Bethel Township and Portland Borough, should the new map be finalized as is, your children will still attend the Bangor School District. The representation of the school district would change to being dually represented by Reps. Jack Rader and Ann Flood.

Recently, the Legislative Reapportionment Commission voted 3-2 in approving PRELIMINARY maps for the new state House districts for the next 10 years. This is separate from and does NOT involve the U.S. congres-

These maps, as currently drawn, would drastically change the way our state would be represented as many of the House legislative districts have been heavily altered.

Below, I have specifically provided a graphic of how the new 137th District, the 138th District (represented by Rep. Ann Flood) and the 176th District (represented by Rep. Jack Rader) would look should this preliminary

The graphic above is a snapshot from the new 2021 preliminary state House map from the Pennsylvania redistricting website redistricting.state. pa.us.

Under this preliminary map:

The 176th District (highlighted in brown) would consist of Upper Mount Bethel Township and Portland Borough and the rest of the district would be located in the West End of Monroe County.

The 138th District (highlighted in light blue) would consist of Bushkill,
