ed Account and Snowmobile Management Restricted Account and the Pennsylvania Recreational Trails Program will support planning, construction or maintenance of ATV and snowmobile trails and facilities.

Grants Locally: Monroe -- Peaceful Woodlands Family Campground, \$55,500, for the development of the Peaceful Woodlands Family Campground ATV Connector Trail in Tunkhannock Township. Work to include construction of 0.1 miles of ATV trail from the campground to the Dixon Miller ATV Trail System.
