## CDBG Grant Applications Open On Feb. 24th

EASTON - Lamont McClure and the Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) announce that the application process for Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) will run from February 24th until 4:00PM on May 26, 2022. This is the 14th anniversary for the Northampton County CDBG program.

Funding for CDBG is provided through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to allow DCED to assist people with low incomes. Eligible applicants are the thirty-six boroughs and townships and the City of Easton which participate in the Northampton County's Urban County CDBG Entitlement program, and 501(c)(3) non-profit organizations which provide services to residents in the participating municipalities.

CDBG grants are used for affordable housing, programs that benefit low-to-moderate income persons, and infrastructure needs. Funds may be applied for such projects as Accessibility improvements to public facilities, capital improvements for water, sewer or other utilities, street paving, sidewalks, curbing and storm water prevention.
