BANGOR - The second-seeded Bangor Slaters (12-3) defeated top-seeded Notre Dame (13-3) 83-75 this past Friday night to win the Colonial league title at Moravian Academy.

Notre Dame took a 40-38 lead into the locker room at halftime, but that didn't bother Bangor who came out strong in the second half.

The Slaters went 21-for-29 from the line, compared to the 11-for-16 for the Crusaders who were outrebounded most of the game. Notre Dame cut the score to 75-74 with a 3-pointer with 1:54 to play
