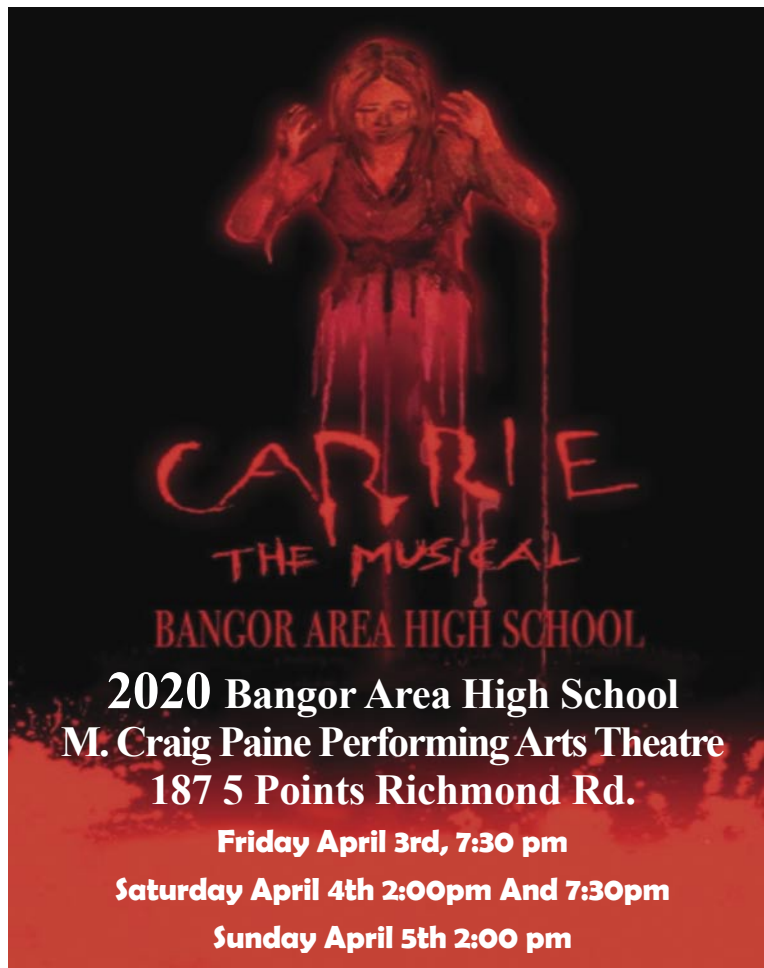

Lehigh Valley Food & Wine Festival Returns for First Festival of the Decade

BETHLEHEM - To kick off a delicious new decade in regional food and wines from around the world, the Lehigh Valley Food & Wine Festival will return June 5-7, 2020, to the Wind Creek Event Center. The festival's signature extensive curated selection of wines, craft spirits, and other beverages, plus tasty and generous samples of the region's top restaurants, will be offered. Come hungry!

Star of TLC's "Cake Boss," Buddy Valastro, and Chef Emeril Lagasse will return to this year's festival, representing their Wind Creek restaurants: Valastro's Buddy V's Ristorante and Carlo's Bakery, and Lagasse's Emeril's Chop House, Emeril's Fish House, and Burgers and More by Emeril.

In addition, Chef Lagasse, who has been part of the festival since the start, will also announce the Northampton Community College students who have won highly-competitive externships to work in his New Orleans restaurants. Each year, students from the college's acclaimed culinary program receive all-expenses-paid externships to gain invaluable experience honing their skills in the celebrated chef's New Orleans kitchens.

The announcement will be made at the opening night premiere party on June 5, which features an extravagant four-course dinner prepared under the direction of Chef Lagasse. The night also includes a live auction to raise funds for NCC student scholarships, featuring four tickets to Chef Emeril Lagasse's Boudin, Bourbon and Beer Festival in Champions Square at the Super Dome in New Orleans, hotel accommodations and dinner at Emeril's restaurants, among many other items.
