### Waste Management and Mission of Love Working **Together for Our Community**

Each past three Monday between 4-6pm cars lined up out side of Waste Management main office where employees spent their time off to load box meals into each car.

Each week Mission of Love volunteer Tim Schnaitman owner of Mother Nature's Way loaded up his 27 ft. trailer with 6 pallets and delivered two of those to Waste Management, a total of 100 boxes, for a total of 300 for the three weeks.

The Mission of Love Food Bank received 27 pallets each week thru the three week period totaling 81 pallets (4050 boxes). The program is run thru the USDA called 'Farms to Family.' Food is shipped directly from farms to processing warehouses who package up the food then shipped to food banks.

Each box has: 1 gallon of milk, two yogurt, 1 bag of onions, apples and potatoes, 1/2 chicken marinated and fully cooked, cheese and hot dogs.
