Businesses such as nail salons, barber shops and hair salons, dental offices, and any other business that can supply these products – particularly ones that are closed temporarily – could help fight the shortage of these items by donating them now.

Businesses should "donate, but don't deplete" their supplies, County Administrator Alex Lazorisak said, as the County wants businesses to be able to reopen when the time comes.

A large coalition of groups is working to urge Congress to quickly pass the Great American Outdoors Act (S. 3422), recently introduced by Senators Gardner (R-CO), Manchin (D-WV), Daines (R-MT) and Warner (D-VA). The bill provides up to \$9.5 billion over five years to address priority repairs to infrastructure managed by the National Park Service, US Fish and Wildlife Service, US Forest Service, Bureau of Land Management and Bureau of Indian Education Schools. It also dedicates \$900 million annually to the Land

and Water Conservation Fund (LWCF), which ensures protection of and access to irreplaceable lands while also supporting recreational facilities in communities across the country, including in our communities along the Delaware River.
