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
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Ballot-on-demand Voting Now Available For The May 17th Primary

EASTON - The Northampton County Elections Office announces that Ballot-on-Demand voting for the May 17th Primary will be available starting Monday, April 25th. Citizens can vote in-person at the Government Center at 669 Washington Street, Easton, PA 18042, Monday through Friday from 8:30AM – 4:30PM. Ballot-on-Demand voting hours will end on May 10th at 5:00PM.

Residents of Northampton County who are eligible to vote can come to the Elections Office, register if they have not already, fill out a ballot application, vote on a paper ballot and turn it in all in the same visit. Showing ID is required before you can receive your ballot.



a mail-in ballot are not eligible for Ballot-on-Demand and must wait to receive their ballot in the mail. The Elections Office began mailing ballots out on April 22nd.

PEN ARGYL AREA SCHOOL DISTRICT RESIDENTS

The Pen Argyl Area School District is offering a property tax rebate program. You may qualify if:

- 1. You have owned and occupied your home during the period for which you are claiming a rebate. Rebates are granted for your primary residence only; and
- (a) You or your spouse (if living with you) were 65 years or older as of December 31, 2021; or
 - (b) You were a widow or widower during all or part of 2021 and were 50 years old or older as of December 31, 2021; or
 - (c) You were permanently disabled during all or part of 2021, and you were unable to work because of your medically determined physical or mental disability which is expected to continue indefinitely; and
- 3. Your total annual income, including the income of a spouse residing with you, was \$35,000 or less in 2021. (IMPORTANT: only report 50% of your Railroad Retirement benefits and 50% of Federal Social Security Act benefits); and
- 4. 2021/22 Pen Argyl School District Real Estate Taxes were paid in full.
- 5. Only one member of your household may file a claim.
- 6. Delinquent taxes DO NOT QUALIFY.

The deadline for filing an application is June 30, 2022
