\$459,420 Grant To Promote Hazard Mitigation Awareness

EASTON - Tucked away in a three-story former movie theater building on Easton's Northampton Street, the Nurture Nature Center will never be confused with Philadelphia's Franklin Institute or Washington D.C.'s National Air and Space Museum.

But then, those internationally renowned science centers haven't been asked to help save the planet by the National Oceanic Atmospheric Administration (NOAA).

The Nurture Nature Center has received a \$459,420 NOAA grant to conduct a fouryear program, titled Create Resilience, to develop partnerships with students, raise awareness to the effects of climate change and promote the Lehigh Valley Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Nurture Nature is one of nine grantees among 237 applicants from across the country, along with such centers as Boston's Museum of Science in Boston, San Diego's Ocean Discovery Institute and the University of Michigan.
