### **SEER Part Deux**

If you have been a reader of this column for a year or more you have definitely seen my explanation of the efficiency standards for heat pumps and air conditioners. I like to refresh everyone's knowledge once in a while so that homeowners can purchase new systems with

confidence that they are getting what they want. SEER stands for Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio and is calculated by how much manufacturers pay the laboratory testing their equipment. Wait, that's not correct. It really tells you how a system stacks up to other brands and other systems of higher or lower efficiency. Without going into all the boring details, let's say it is comparable to MPG for a car. Obviously a car with higher MPG will be less expensive to operate. In a few years cars will probably be rated by MPC (miles per charge) but for now it's MPG.

SEER really is only a number that means something about cooling but it is the baseline we use for heat pumps too. There are other alphabet soups that pertain to heat pumps like HSPF, and COP but literally nobody knows what they mean. Apparently during the covid lockdown (my assumption) a lot of people in the government had very little to do since they could not be out campaigning so they decided to rewrite the standards for air conditioners. Starting in 2023 there is a new standard and it is going to be called, get this, SEER2. It doesn't really change anything but it means that if you had a 14 SEER air conditioner last

year, it is now a SEER2 13.4. They didn't actually sneak out to your home and reduce the efficiency of your unit, they just changed the rules. It's sadder for people who had a 20 SEER unit because that dropped all the way to 18 SEER2. They are working on the dollar too. Pretty soon your dollar will be worth 80 cents. Maybe they will call it dollar2. In any case, this new rule doesn't mean anything to anyone except the people who print literature and labels for manufacturers, they will be busy. The end result is exactly what you would expect, confusion and lots of hot air coming out of DC about new 'standards'. In my opinion if they wanted to make a real difference, they would just keep the old standard and prevent people from using anything under 16 SEER. That's 15.3 SEER2 for next year. That is the best value in any brand based on installed cost and operating cost.
