

Update on Route 611 Road Closure

By Senator Scavello PEN ARGYL - This week, PennDOT's Monroe County Maintenance office will begin repair work on Rt. 611. This portion of the roadway, connecting Portland and Delaware Water Gap was closed on April 7th, due to a slope and retaining wall washout caused by heavy rain.

Repairs will include the removal and resetting of 517

sections of concrete barriers. They are removing the sections, shoring up the base material for support, and then resetting the section. Once this is complete, four areas of the roadway must be repaired. Two areas will be shored up with fill material, and the other two will have concrete slabs constructed to provide support for the roadway.

Pending availability of materials and weather, PennDOT is ESTIMATING this section of Rt. 611 will be open by the end of spring.
