Green Camping

HARRISBURG - Green camping has a lot to do with simply using common sense. For example, using a battery pack or solar charging unit instead of firing up your vehicle to charge your cell phone. Here are some other tips to keep your camping trips eco-friendly:

Buy used or rent your gear. The lowest-impact product is often the one that already exists. Before buying a new piece of gear, consider buying used gear, renting your gear, or repairing the gear you do have. The longer you can keep a product in use, the longer you're avoiding the impact that new products have on the environment.

Bring reusable dishes. It may be tempting to toss the paper plates and plastic forks into your pack, but it's best to bring reusable silverware, plates, and cookware. There are a variety of greener options available -- from lightweight titanium plates to foldable plastic bowls that take up virtually no space -- that you'll be able to reuse for all your outdoor adventures.

Make your own snacks. As you plan your meals try to think about the waste created by the packaging your food comes in. Buy bulk food like trail mix and bring it in a reusable container with little packaging waste. Some products, like reusable bee's wax wraps, are a great way to keep homemade trail food fresh without loading your pack

with plastic bags. Leave No Trace! The core of "Leave No Trace Camping" is the idea that no one should know you've been there after you've gone. No litter should be left, fire pits should be cold, grass, brush, and boulders should be undisturbed. It also means staying on the marked trail, never picking plants, flowers, or berries, and never harming or disturbing wildlife.
