The question reads: Do you favor expanding the use of the indebtedness authorized under the referendum for loans to volunteer fire companies, volunteer ambulance services and volunteer rescue squads under 35 PA.C.S. §7378.1 (related to referendum for additional indebtedness) to include loans to municipal fire departments or companies that provide services through paid personnel and emergency medical services companies for the purpose of establishing and modernizing facilities to house apparatus equipment, ambulances and rescue vehicles, and for purchasing apparatus equipment, ambulances and rescue vehicles, protective and communications equipment and any other accessory equipment necessary for the proper performance of the duties of the fire companies and emergency medical services companies?

Who is in favor? The measure passed the legislature with unanimous support from both the Democrats and Republicans. The Pennsylvania Fire Emergency Services Institute is urging a "yes" vote, as is the Pennsylvania Career Fire Chiefs Association.

We join with fire and EMS leaders from across the state of Pennsylvania and ask you to vote "yes" to approve the referendum on Act 2020-91.
