
Bangor Womens Club GFWC Announces Scholarship Winner Evan Gordon

2020 National Field Hockey Division II Senior Team

BROCKPORT, N.Y. - Senior Cheyenne Ott (Mount Bethel, Pa. / Bangor Area) of the Bloomsburg University field hockey team has been named one of 38 student-athletes across the country to the 2020 National Field Hockey Coaches Association (NFHCA) Division II Senior Team as announced by the

The in-person 2020 NFHCA Senior Game was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. However, during the 2021 Virtual Coaches Caucus, the NFHCA Division II membership agreed to continue to recognize a selected group from the graduating class of 2021 who either played or would have played their senior season during the 2020-21 academic year. The selected student-athletes were nominated by their NFHCA-member coach and were chosen based on their career accomplishments.

Ott has been a three-time NFHCA Division II Scholar of Distinction for achieving a cumulative grade point average of 3.90 or better during her collegiate career. She was also selected as a four-time honoree of the NFHCA National Academic Squad

for having a cumulative grade point average of 3.30 or better. Ott was one of only 60 student-athletes across the country to be a four-year recipient of the award earlier this spring. The early childhood edu-





has also been a three-time Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) Scholar-Athlete as well as a two-time D2 ADA Scholar-Athlete. She should receive both of those honors again later this sum-

On the field, Ott registered four goals and four assists for 12 points in her collegiate career. She posted career-highs in goals (2), assists (2), and points (6) during the 2019 campaign. Both of her goals were game-winners in backto-back home victories over Seton Hill and Frostburg State.

Back in 2017, Ott recorded her first career goal, and her first collegiate assist, in her first-ever game at Queens University of Charlotte.
