BROCKPORT, N.Y. - Senior Cheyenne Ott (Mount Bethel, Pa. / Bangor Area) of the Bloomsburg University field hockey team has been named one of 38 student-athletes across the country to the 2020 National Field Hockey Coaches Association (NFHCA) Division II Senior Team as announced by the organization.

The in-person 2020 NFHCA Senior Game was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. However, during the 2021 Virtual Coaches Caucus, the NFHCA Division II membership agreed to continue to recognize a selected group from the graduating class of 2021 who either played or would have played their senior season during the 2020-21 academic year. The selected student-athletes were nominated by their NFHCA-member coach and were chosen based on their career accomplishments.

Ott has been a three-time NFHCA Division II Scholar of Distinction for achieving a cumulative grade point average of 3.90 or better during her collegiate career. She was also selected as a four-time honoree of the NFHCA National Academic Squad

for having a cumulative grade point average of 3.30 or better. Ott was one of only 60 student-athletes across the country to be a four-year recipient of the award earlier this spring. The early childhood education / special education major



has also been a three-time Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference (PSAC) Scholar-Athlete as well as a two-time D2 ADA Scholar-Athlete. She should receive both of those honors again later this summer.

On the field, Ott registered four goals and four assists for 12 points in her collegiate career. She posted career-highs in goals (2), assists (2), and points (6) during the 2019 campaign. Both of her goals were game-winners in back-to-back home victories over Seton Hill and Frostburg State.

Back in 2017, Ott recorded her first career goal, and her first collegiate assist, in her first-ever game at Queens University of Charlotte.
