Senate Acts to Improve PA Broadband

- Removing regulatory barriers to broadband deployment for landline telecommunications providers. (SB 341)
- Dedicating revenue from leasing state-owned towers & land to cell carriers to expanding high-speed access. (SB 442)

Measures Aimed at Improving Broadband Access Approved

PEN ARGYL - The Senate approved two measures aimed at bringing high-speed broadband service to more areas of Pennsylvania. One bill would remove regulatory barriers to broadband deployment for landline telecommunications providers. The legislation would require the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to waive certain regulations, review regulations every three years and eliminate those that are no longer necessary or in the public interest. A second measure would fund access to broadband by using revenue from renting excess wireless capacity on towers, land, and assets owned by the Commonwealth. The bills were sent to the House of Representatives for consideration.
