

THE PARADE ROUTE IS CHANGED FOR THIS YEAR

The parade begins at the William Pensyl Social Hall on State Street, Portland, PA.

The parade route is as follow:

From the Dunkin Donuts on Route 611 Portland turning left onto Delaware Avenue. Turning left onto Turkey Ridge Road. Turning left onto Saddle Creek Drive. Turning left onto Million Dollar Hwy. Turning right onto Ramblewood. Turning left onto Totts Gap Road. Going straight onto Johnsonville Road. Crosses Route 512 onto Orchard Road. Turning left onto Evergreen Road. Turning right onto Independence Road into Evergreen Village. Turning left onto Flintlock passing the clubhouse. Turning left on Revolutionary. Turning left onto Powderhorn. Turning right on Independence exiting Evergreen Village. Turning right onto Evergreen Road to Route 611. Parade ends at Route 611

SCAVENGER HUNT: Fun at Ice Lake

POCONOS - Brodhead Watershed Association offers an adventure to young people wanting to get outside for a while: a scavenger hunt at Ice Lake in Monroe County, Pa.

Ice Lake is a little jewel of a preserve in Barrett Township – 70+ acres perfect for outdoor fun for families.

Armed with a checklist of natural features to find (see brodheadwatershed.org/gopoconos for a printable list), kids can "collect" the scavenger items by snapping a picture. The hunt will include a huge old oak tree, hay-scented fern, lichen, a baby hemlock tree, wintergreen, barberry, witch hazel, and a very notable boulder.

It's not just the scavenger hunt that will interest kids. There is a lot to see at the lake: fish jumping for insects, pollywogs basking on sunny underwater branches, and the deep "galoom-galoom" of bullfrogs. A log bridge spans Hardytown Run, and a dam provides a selfie background at the mossy waterfall where the creek leaves the lake, picks up speed and bubbles downstream.

A great way – and a great place – for a fun family getaway

IF YOU GO: SCAVENGER HUNT

The scavenger hunt is fun for adults and elementary-age children

- Ice Lake is off Route 390 in Cresco, Pa. GPS coordinates: 41.147435. -75.289393
- The trail is mixed: wide and well-groomed in some places, rocky and narrow in others. A hiking stick is helpful for balance. Stay on trails — poison ivy is abundant.
- Go to brodheadwatershed. org/gopoconos for information on Ice Lake as well as other hikes in the Get Outdoors Poconos series. The series is administered by Brodhead Watershed Association and supported by a grant from the William Penn Foundation.
