Historic preservation grant provided to D&L National Heritage Corridor

HARRISBURG, June 5 – The Delaware & Lehigh National Heritage Corridor today was awarded a \$25,000 state grant, announced Rep. Robert Freeman.

"It is vitally important that we preserve our historic structures so future generations of Pennsylvanians can learn from our past. I am proud to help direct state dollars toward our area to accomplish this task and others like it," said Freeman, D-Northampton.

Over the last 30 years, the corridor has created historic contexts and conducted inventories of the Lehigh Navigation Canal but has not planned comprehensively for how to manage the physical structures of the Lehigh Canal so that this engineering system is not lost through deterioration.

The Keystone Historic Preservation Grant will allow the corridor to develop a plan for the entire 47 miles of Lehigh Canal in Carbon, Lehigh and Northampton counties.

Freeman said the funds were awarded by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission.
