

Girl Scouts from Troops 8341 and 8061 joined Landfill Manager Joe Statile and Community Relations Specialist Adrienne Fors this month to learn the do's and don'ts of recycling right.

"Never put plastic bags in the recycling bin." stated Ms. Fors. "These items are considered tanglers and jam up our sorting system."

Mr. Statile added that landfills are an important part of the equation as facilities like Grand Central provide a disposal solution for the items that can't be recycled.

Mr. Statile added, "We invest millions into our landfill facilities. Landfills are highly engineered facilities with multiple layers of protection

that isolates wastes from the environment. They no longer resemble the garbage dumps of previous generations; and at WM we are creating green solutions from ordinary waste."

Troop members discussed items that they keep out of their recycle bins and helped the Wind Gap Fire Company prepare for day two of the firemans carnival.

Did you know that the U.S. EPA estimates that textile waste occupies nearly 5% of all landfill space? (we know. mind blown!) So what can you do to help keep textiles out of landfills? For starters, buy only what you need and repurpose or recycle the clothing when possible.


June 1st- July 15 Thank you for your support!

Please place your gently used/unwanted items in tightly tied bags. Every bag counts. Give your items a second chance to be worn/used again. The more our collection weighs the more we raise.


