



Families First 2020 Scholarship Recipients



Dark Secrets

There are a number of things that must be cleaned, verified, and measured while balancing on 2 thin pieces of wood usually in near total darkness during an air conditioner tune-up in an attic. Since condensed humidity is really just distilled water, it needs to be drained away from the fan unit. There are some general laws of nature that make it difficult. Water flows downhill, that adds complexity right off the bat. It would be so cool if there were some waterfalls that went from a pool in the earth up to the top of a mountain but mother nature won't allow that in a national park or in your attic. If that is the case then why do installers run drain pipes uphill? The rule is that a small drain pipe like we use for condensate must go downhill at the rate of 1/2" per foot. This means that in 10' of pipe the far end would be 5" lower than the starting end. It could be easy if the fan unit was installed on a platform or suspended from the roof but when it is dropped on top of the framing in the attic, there is usually no downhill place to go with the water. When water lays in the pipe, it forms algae and eventually clogs and causes an overflow. There also needs to be a secondary drain pan under the fan unit. It needs to be larger than the unit and it needs to be supported well in case it has to catch water. Many jobs are 0 for 2 on that score. There also needs to be an alert for the occupants when water actually flows into the pan because it is not just there to be a swimming pool for stink bugs. I prefer not to drain those pans into the same drain as the unit because one clog will insure a drywall repair job on the ceiling. My preference is to install a water safety switch in that pan. It will stop the outdoor unit when there is water danger. The indoor fan will continue to run but there will be no cooling and no more condensate will be produced. Once an attic spelunker reaches the flooded unit in total darkness and determines the source of the overflow, it can be resolved and the system will come back on. Sometimes people get upset that the cooling stopped but if you have ever had buckets under every recessed light in your living room catching water, it's not such a bad thing to lose the
