American Marten Reintroduction Assessment

HARRISBURG - The Pennsylvania Board of Game Commissioners took the next step in considering American Marten reintroduction at its meeting on Saturday. Click here to learn more about the species.

The American marten is a native species to Pennsylvania that was extirpated by the early 1920's due to deforestation and unregulated harvest. It weighs between 1-3 pounds and is the same size as the American mink.

The next step in the process includes the Bureau of Wildlife Management developing a plan for reintroduction and management, which will identify optimal release sites, potential source populations, as well as specifics on translocation methodology, research and monitoring, cooperative partnerships and long-term management.
