## Senator McCormick Announces \$10 Billion Investment Supporting Nearly 5,000 PA Jobs

Last week, I hosted the Pennsylvania Defense & Innovation Summit at the U.S. Army War College in Carlisle, where I was joined by President Donald J. Trump, senior administration officials, military leaders, top defense and technology executives, leading investors, and innovators from across the country to strengthen America's defense industrial base.

Over two days, the Summit catalyzed more than \$10 billion in new investment supporting nearly 5,000 Pennsylvania jobs, with more than 30 major announcements advancing shipbuilding, munitions production, AI, robotics, space, advanced manufacturing, and workforce development. Building on the momentum of last year's Energy & Innovation Summit, Pennsylvania is once again proving we have the workforce, innovation, and industrial strength to lead the next generation of American defense and help rebuild the Arsenal of Democracy.

### Investments in Pennsylvania

The Pennsylvania Defense & Innovation Summit showcased major investments that are rebuilding America's defense industrial base right here in the Commonwealth. From shipbuilding and munitions production to advanced manufacturing and critical defense technologies, these announcements will strengthen our national security while creating thousands of good paying jobs across Pennsylvania.

Rhoads Industries & General Dynamics Electric Boat announced a 10-year, \$2.5 billion strategic partnership to expand submarine manufacturing at the Philadelphia Navy Yard, supporting approximately 1,350 jobs through 2035.

Hanwha Philadelphia Shipyard secured new National Security Multi-Mission Vessel orders valued at \$1.5 billion, supporting more than 2,000 Pennsylvania jobs while helping revitalize American shipbuilding.

JPMorganChase committed nearly \$25 million to strengthen Philadelphia's shipbuilding ecosystem by expanding submarine manufacturing, supporting workforce training, and investing in small businesses across the maritime supply chain.

Day & Zimmermann was awarded a \$2.3 billion contract to provide operations, maintenance, and modernization services for the Hawthorne Army Depot, reinforcing the company's longstanding defense manufacturing presence in Pennsylvania.

Eos Energy Enterprises entered a strategic partnership with the Department of War and received a Golden Dome for America contract to provide long-duration energy storage supporting America's next generation missile defense capabilities.

JWF Industries announced more than \$500 million in anticipated defense manufacturing contracts alongside a major facility expansion in Cambria County that is expected to create approximately 200 new jobs.

Mack Defense received an additional Army order for Heavy Dump Trucks, bringing its 2026 production to more than 200 vehicles as part of a contract worth up to \$221.8 million.

Air, formerly Govini, announced a 10-year, \$450 million expansion of its Pittsburgh operations, further strengthening Pennsylvania's growing defense technology sector.

Attalon announced a new 80,000-square-foot headquarters in Philadelphia that will more than quadruple U.S. precision coatings production for guided munitions while creating 100 new jobs.

Kratos Defense unveiled a new advanced manufacturing facility in York, supported by more than \$7 million in new production equipment and expanding the company's Pennsylvania footprint.

Karman Space & Defense announced a \$2.7 million expansion in Montgomery County to advance testing of next-generation materials supporting the U.S. Navy.

Advanced Cooling Technologies will expand production in Lancaster with a new 50,000-square-foot facility producing advanced thermal systems for satellites, defense platforms, and AI data centers.

Sphere Brake Defense secured a new U.S. Marine Corps contract supporting production of critical Amphibious Combat Vehicle components in Erie.

Acutronic Group announced a major investment in a new Pittsburgh facility that will become the world's largest dedicated center for advanced motion simulation and testing, doubling its Pennsylvania workforce over the next five years.

U.S. Metal Powders / AMPAL will expand production in Carbon County with a fourth manufacturing line supporting missile defense and solid rocket motor programs.

Firepoint Energy announced plans to convert Pennsylvania waste coal into synthetic jet fuel, electricity, and critical minerals, unlocking a new domestic source of strategic resources.

Qintel secured a new multi-year contract supporting U.S. Cyber Command while continuing to grow its Pittsburgh headquarters and cybersecurity capabilities.

Lockheed Martin announced a more than \$60 million investment to double the size of its Archbald facility, expand production of critical munitions, and create approximately 700 new Pennsylvania jobs.
