Homeownership 201

If I had a dollar for every emergency switch I talked a customer through checking and turning on in the basement stairway, I wouldn't need to write this article every week to pay my advertising bill. If I had 5 dollars for every customer who didn't even know this switch existed, I wouldn't need to advertise at all because I'd be retired and on a beach in Honolulu. Many people are not comfortable changing their air filters or doing other small tasks that I put inside the homeowner responsibility bubble and we are in business to do things like that. I couldn't afford to pay someone to fix every small thing that goes wrong in my home and I try to help others with information as much as possible. I wouldn't call the seminar 'homeownership for dummies' because everyone is a dummy until they're not and not wanting to be one means you're not one in the first place. Maybe I'd call it homeownership 201. I think my biggest problem would be keeping it interesting since I am a pretty boring guy. I have some pretty awesome friends that might help though.
