## REAL ID Deadline Quickly Approaching

BANGOR - Beginning May
3, 2023, Pennsylvanians will
need a REAL ID-compliant
license/identification card, or
another form of federally-acceptable identification (such
as a valid passport or military
ID) to board domestic commercial

flights, enter a military base and enter a federal facility that requires ID at the door.

You do NOT need a REAL ID to drive, vote, access hospitals, visit the post office, access federal courts and apply for or receive federal benefits, such as social security or veterans' benefits.



REAL ID is optional for Pennsylvania residents. You will be able to get either a REAL ID driver's license/ identification card, or a standard driver's license or identification card.

If you do not get a REAL ID, you must have an alternate form of federally-acceptable identification (valid passport, military ID, etc.) to board domestic commercial flights and enter certain federal facilities after May 3, 2023
