Mark Your Calendars for Our Senior Fair



Auditor General DePasquale Applauds Gov. Wolf's Endorsement of Marijuana Reform

HARRISBURG – Auditor General Eugene DePasquale today applauded Gov. Tom Wolf for calling on the General Assembly to reform Pennsylvania's marijuana laws as part of criminal justice reform.

"It's time for public policy to catch up with public opinion," DePasquale said, noting that recreational marijuana for adults has been approved in numerous other states and Washington, D.C.

"My research shows that regulating and taxing marijuana for adult use could generate up to \$581 million in new revenue annually – money

that Pennsylvania could use to strengthen support for education, fight opioid addiction and expand access to health care," DePasquale added.

DePasquale was Pennsylvania's first statewide elected official to publicly support regulating and taxing marijuana and highlighted the potential economic benefits of doing so in a July 2018 special report. It noted that an average of 8.38 percent of Pennsylvania's adults (21 and older), or nearly 800,000 people, currently use marijuana at least monthly.

Research shows a majority of Americans now support legalizing recreational marijuana for adults, with support rising from 27 percent in 1979 to 65 percent in 2019.

HARRISBURG - A state program designed to help people with qualified disabilities save for future disability-related expenses has more than doubled its assets in just one year, reflecting the high level of popularity and need for this savings option. PA ABLE provides a tax-advantaged way for Pennsylvanians with disabilities and their families to save. Participation does not jeopardize access to state and federal programs, such as Supplemental Security Income (savings up to \$100,000) and Medical

Assistance. But it does allow for savings to be used to pay for any qualified disability-related expense including housing, education, health care and assistive technology to improve quality of life. Administered by the State Treasury, the program has more than \$18.4 million in assets, up from \$8.6 million in July 2018.
