SLATE BELT - As September draws to a close, so does National Childhood Cancer Awareness Month. But eradicating cancer among all Pennsylvanians, especially our children, should always be a top priority.

The most common cancer in children is leukemia, a type of blood cancer. Cancer can also occur in organs and tissues such as the lymph nodes (lymphoma), nervous system (brain tumors) and muscles, bone and skin (solid tumors).

According to St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, 43 children in the United States are diagnosed with cancer every day. Worldwide, about 400,000 children and adolescents are diagnosed with cancer each year.

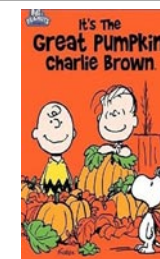
Cancer is the leading cause of death by disease past infancy for U.S. children. However, due to improved treatment and therapies, more than 80% of U.S. childhood cancer patients now become long-term survivors.
