"Save Us From The NJDOT I-80 Rockfall Plan"

UPPER MT. BETHEL - John Bermingham Chairman, UMBT Supervisors is asking Upper Mount Bethel and our surrounding communities to "Please come out on Friday, October 25th at 6pm at the Mount Bethel Fire House for an informational meeting about the Rt. 80 Rock Wall Project that will greatly impact our area! We need to hear from you about your questions, concerns and whether you are for or against this from impacting our Township for the next several years" said Bermingham.

A group of people from both Pa. and N.J. have joined together to fight the 'Rock Wall' plan and there is a website for people to sign a petetion against it.

"We continue to oppose the I-80 ROCKFALL PLAN for the reasons listed below as they remain unresolved. In addition on Sept 4th the NJDOT stated: that the department is "confident" that the project "will be constructed with unimpeded traffic flow and without direct impact to the local economy." REALITY CHECK! It is not possible to construct anything in the s-Curve without a lane closure. It is not possible due to it's design. This has been certified by an expert in the field. OFF PEAK CONSTRUCTION WILL CREATE GRIDLOCK" says the group.

Tourism Threaten by Two Interstate 80 Projects

The other part of this problem is Stroudsburg Borough officials are strategizing ways to improve Interstate 80 through their area without widening the busy roadway from four lanes to six lanes. They've formed a task force to fight what's known as the Interstate 80 Reconstruction Project that's expected to start in the fall of 2022.

PennDOT officials say, "There are a lot of ramps that are close together and they don't have very long ramps and that becomes a safety issue and there's just in general a lot of work that needs to be done. Whenever there's a crash out on the Interstate, we know that a lot of traffic dumps out to the local traffic and can really bottleneck a lot of your local roads."

Meanwhile, New Jersey residents are fighting to stop a rock wall along Interstate 80 just before the road enters Pennsylvania that's expected to start in 2023. Now the two task forces are teaming up because both projects are happening at the same, which we're told is going to hit tourism hard. Stroudsburg Borough Mayor Tarah Probst says, "If all these projects really go through, they're going to happen at the same time. It will kill our tourism."

The Mayor encourages anyone relying on tourism to get in touch with the I-80 Project Impact Task Force. Probst says, "We will hurt and we will hurt for about four years from this so it's really important to get involved."


