science, technology, engineering, art, and math (STEAM) education, and enhance the quality of life for local residents, including the more than 50,000 people who live within a one-mile walk of the new site. The new science center will offer a wide range of programs for residents, with a particular emphasis on school children and their family members. Programs for pre-K, elementary, middle, and high-school students will reinforce and complement in-school STEAM studies and encourage students to further their education and pursue STEAM careers.

"We are thrilled to support the project," said Allentown Mayor Ray O'Connell. "The new science center will open-up Da Vinci to tens of thousands of new visitors and expand their mission of bringing science to life and lives to science. This project has the potential to be transformative, setting the future direction of our city for decades."
